Post-Operative Instructions

Canine: Farley

On November 9, 2016 **Farley** was neutered, given his rabies vaccination, micro-chipped, and skin scraped. He is demodex positive. Please keep him in a quiet place this evening and let him rest. He may have water the remainder of today. You can feed him a light meal tomorrow morning and his normal amount tomorrow evening.

Farley has sutures that will dissolve and normally do not need to be removed. His incision will need to stay clean and dry for one week. Please do not bathe him during this time and he should be kept in a clean dry area – inside or crated if possible.

Farley is being sent home with NexGard ²⁴⁻⁶⁰ ~~10-24~~ lbs x 1 and Interceptor Plus 10-25lbs x 1. Excessive licking or chewing at the surgical site can cause worse swelling and additional complications and should be discouraged. Being around females in heat or attempts to breed can also cause complications and is to be avoided.
