## **Post-Operative Instructions**

Canine: Bailey

On May 3, 2016 **Bailey** was spayed, given her rabies vaccination, and micro-chipped. She was also Snap IV tested and is positive for Ehrlichia. Please keep her in a quiet place this evening and let her rest. She may have water the remainder of today. You can feed her a light meal tomorrow morning and her normal amount tomorrow evening.

**Bailey** has sutures that will dissolve and normally do not need to be removed. Her incision will need to stay clean and dry for one week. Please do not bathe her during this time and she should be kept in a clean dry area – inside or crated if possible.

Bailey is being sent home with Doxycycline 400mg. Give her ½ pill twice a day for 28 days.

Excessive licking or chewing at the surgical site can cause additional complications and should be discouraged.
