Post-Operative Instructions

Canine: Kat, Heidi, Sadie, Kimba, Jane, Cassie, & Kit

On March 8, 2016 Kat, Heidi, Sadie, Kimba, Jane, Cassie, & Kit were spayed and micro-chipped. Please keep them in a quiet place this evening and let them rest. They may have water the remainder of today. You can feed them a light meal tomorrow morning and their normal amount tomorrow evening.

Kat, Heidi, Sadie, Kimba, Jane, Cassie, & Kit have sutures that will dissolve and normally do not need to be removed. Their incisions will need to stay clean and dry for one week. Please do not bathe them during this time and they should be kept in a clean dry area – inside or crated if possible.

Excessive licking or chewing at the surgical site can cause additional complications and should be discouraged.
