Approach:	Regular incision over the base of the penis, just anterior to the scrotum.
Procedure:	Testicles removed through incision individually. The tunica is incised to expose the testicle. The scrotal ligament is exposed and ligated with 2-0 PDS - II. The spermatic cord is double clamped and ligated with 2-0 PDS - II. The second testicle is removed with a repeat procedure.
Closure:	Routine closure. Subcutaneous and subcuticular closure with simple continuous suture. Skin closed with surgical glue.
Recovery:	Uneventful
