Post-Operative Instructions

Canine: Wally

On November 27, 2017 Wally was neutered and micro-chipped. Please keep him in a quiet place this evening and let him rest. He may have water the remainder of today. You can feed him a light meal tumorrow morning and his normal amount tomorrow evening.

Wally has sutures that will dissolve and normally do not need to be removed. His incision will need to stay clean and dry for one week. Please do not bathe him during this time and he should be kept in a clean dry area — inside or crated if possible. Excessive licking or chewing at the surgical site, as well as attempts to breed can cause additional complications and should be discouraged.

Wally can remain fertile for up to 60-90 days after surgery and should not be allowed contact with females in heat during this time.
